Clubhouse & Party Reservation Information

Party and Clubroom Rental Overview

- All reservations & hours are determined by availability, and are on a first come, first serve basis.
- All reservations require Manager's approval; please submit form with two weeks' advanced notice.
- Hosting a party without a form may be reported.
- Clubroom rentals allow any number of members and non-members without counting towards the member host's annual guest quota of 35, but access to the rest of the facility is restricted.
- Parties are allowed access to the facility outside the clubroom, but non-member guests are counted towards the annual guest quota of 35 (except in the case of non-member guests attending the birthday party of a member's child). Guests beyond the annual guest quota are \$3 each per visit.
- All members are responsible for their guests. Non-member guests are not permitted to stay after the host member leaves the club.
- If club reservation requirements are ignored, there is damage to the facilities, etc., the privilege of reserving the facilities for future functions may be withdrawn at the discretion of the BOG. The BOG reserves the right to charge members for attending guests if protocol is not followed.
- Users of the clubhouse are asked to be respectful of Eichler neighbors – please limit noise, both inside the Eichler facilities and outside in the parking lot, especially if functions run into the evening.
- No member may sign up for more than two events at a time; the member must have his/her first party before booking a subsequent (third) party, and so on. Exceptions made for events open to all members.
- A single organization can reserve a maximum of once a month, a member must be present.
- No storage for members in club room, no party may make money off of their event.
- After hours reservations: BOG approval needed for reservations past closing. Party Reservations no later than 9pm, and require payment for Lifeguard hours past closing are required. Club Room reservations must end no later than 10pm, and we ask that you be very mindful of noise.

Clubroom Rental Fees & Details

- \$50 Flat fee for *exclusive* use of clubhouse
- Rental Fee may be waived if clubhouse is reserved for member-only function (open to all members)
- Eichler reserves the right to invoice the member host for an amount, as determined by the Manager to cover the cost of repairs, replacement of property, or additional cleaning.
- Clubhouse must be left clean and undamaged. Please leave it in the same condition in which it was rented.
- Children are not to be left unattended in clubhouse during a clubhouse function.
- Tennis courts and pool deck are off limits; this is especially important after pool is closed.
- BOG approval needed for: reservations past 9pm generally no later than 11pm), or exclusive use of the clubhouse building.

Party Facility Usage Information

- Party Reservations of any kind are free, unless additional pool party staff is required for safety, or if the reservation is for *exclusive* use of the Clubroom in addition to use of the facilities. Pool party staffing costs are \$20 per hour; details below.
- BBQ Area reservations & hours are determined by availability, on a first come, first serve basis. Deck Areas, especially the BBQ Area, may need to be shared. Reservations have some priority, and may claim tables when preparing to set up.
- Please clean up your area; Eichler is a shared space, and everyone deserves a clean environment.

Pool Party Requirements

- Children are not to be left unattended.
- Lap Pool Supervision: One dedicated parent supervisor on deck for each 10 children in the lap pool.
- Parents must supervise their children when using the wading pool.
- Party host is responsible for making sure their guests know the rules in addition to enforcing them.
- Non-Swimmers need a parent within arm's reach in addition to supervisors.
- Lifeguard may restrict the number of party swimmers in the pool at one time if deemed unsafe.
- Additional Lifeguards may be required if you plan to have more than 25 participants in the water.
- If extra staff is needed, the cost to be paid by member hosting the party at \$20/hour/staff member.
- Parties with Non-Members & children may be required to have an orientation & swim test before being allowed full access to the pool. This is for the safety of the members and guests.
- Depending on party size, the Manager may require that a pool party take place during non-peak hours.

Eichler Swim & Tennis Club Rental and Hold Harmless/Waiver Agreement

I/We agree to abide by the rules and responsibilities set forth above and to assume responsibility for and pay for any costs incurred by Eichler Swim & Tennis Club resulting from any misuse of the facilities or non-compliance with the above rules and responsibilities. I/We further agree that no one in my/our party will use the pool unless authorized to do so by the Manager and unless a lifeguard is on duty. In consideration of my/our use of the facilities of Eichler Swim & Tennis Club and to the fullest extent permitted by law, I/we agree to indemnify, defend and hold harmless Eichler Swim & Tennis Club, its governors, employees and representatives from and against all claims (of every kind, nature and character) arising out of or resulting from my/our/our party's use of these facilities. Further, to the fullest extent permitted by law, I/we hereby waive all rights I/we may have to sue Eichler Swim & Tennis Club, its governors, employees and representatives with respect to any personal injury, property damage or losses suffered by me/us/our party as a result of our using the facilities and hereby release Eichler Swim & Tennis Club, its governors, employees and representatives from any liability for such injury, damage or losses. 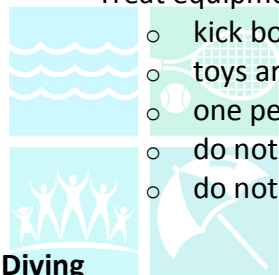
The Lifeguards are here to assist you in supervising the safety of your children. Infractions are reported.

Deck

- Members & Guests must sign in.
- Respect the authority of the lifeguard on all safety matters.
- No pets, smoking, or weapons in the pool area or locker rooms.
- Glass allowed only in Club Room. Infraction fines are up to \$2,000
- Non-swimmers and children under 12 must be accompanied by an adult.
- Children in the Wading pool must have adult supervision.

Pool

- Proper swimwear required.
- Weak swimmers & non-swimmers must have a parent in the water within arm's reach, even with a flotation device.
- No excessive horseplay or wrestling; No standing on shoulders; no hanging on a swimmer who can't stand.
- Patrons may have to demonstrate their swimming ability before entering deep water.
- Treat equipment with respect:



- kick boards & buoys are for lap swimmers
- toys are not weapons
- one person per flotation device
- do not sink the lane line
- do not climb or hang on handrails, diving board or pool cover rollers.

Diving

- No diving in the shallow end
- No back dives
- Request permission to open the diving board from the lifeguard
- For safety purposes, all diving board rules must be strictly followed:
 - one diver on the board at a time
 - one bounce; jump straight out
 - Swim immediately to the closest wall or ladder
 - All swimmers, including the previous diver, must be on the wall before starting your dive
- Starting blocks may only be used when accompanied by an Eichler Swim Instructor

Lap Lanes

- Lifeguards have the final authority on the use of Lap Lanes; please use your judgment.
- Adult Lap swimmers have priority in the lap lanes, but may be required to share
 - Organized groups of younger lap-swimmers (3 or more) sharing a lane will not be removed if an adult is requesting a lane to themselves.
- Non-lap swimmers may use the lap lanes if *more than one* lap lane is empty.
- Swim Instructors should be alerted when new lap swimmers arrive, so they may move out of the lap lanes.
